NEW REGISTRATION PROCESS FOR **FREMONT No. 25 SCHOOLS**

Fremont County School District No. 25 is excited to announce an online student registration/data validation system for the upcoming school year, powered by InfoSnap, that will allow the district to collect and verify all student demographic, emergency and medical information in a condensed format for your child prior to the start of the new school year. This online system will replace the majority of the hard copy student registration and permission forms that are required each year.

When it is time to fill out the online form, you will receive a letter from Fremont County School District No. 25 with instructions on how to access the system for your student. The letter will contain a link with instructions and a secure “snapcode” that links directly to your student’s information and should arrive early August. If we have your correct email on file, you will also receive an email. If you receive both an email and a letter you can use either to complete your child’s registration but you do not need to do both. You will create an account, that you will use each year for this process, and submit a form for each student in your family. To make the process easier for families with multiple students, you will have the option to copy all generic family information to all other students in your family.

We would appreciate all families completing the online process as soon as possible after receiving the letter. Your student’s registration will not be complete until the online forms have been submitted. If you do not have access to the Internet, or need help using the system, please contact your child’s school. If you do not receive a letter with your child’s snapcode by August 7, please contact your student’s school office.
